

Jane Neale Memorial Hike



Round Mountain Loop Sunday, August 25, 2013

Join members of the ADK and friends of Jane Neale for the annual Jane Neale memorial hike. This is a fundraising event in support of the **Jane Neale Fund**, established by ADK to support participation by youth in the annual trails crew week. Contributions are most welcome and are fully tax deductible.

Round Mountain Loop, Dix Mountain Wilderness Area. Distances: from Ausable Club Road to summit of Round Mt. 2.3 miles, to intersection with Old Dix trail 0.7 miles, back to from Ausable Club Road 1.6 miles. Total loop distance 4.6 miles (7.4 km). Total ascent: 1,820 feet. Grade: Easy to moderate hike with steep pitches.

We will start out from the parking lot on Ausable Club Road near Rte 73. Marked with red markers, the trail proceeds along a steep bank with good views of the Giant Mtn Wilderness area. At 0.4 miles the trail swings to the right with mostly easy grades. After crossing a brook and mossy slide at 1.3 miles the trail passes through a series of steep pitches and ledges with excellent views of Giant Mtn to 1.9 miles. After a wooded flat and a short steep pitch, the trail emerges onto open rocks at 2.1 miles. The now nearly flat route is marked with cairns until the intersection with the connector to the Old Dix Trail at 2.2 miles. The summit is just beyond at 2.3 miles with excellent views in all directions. After a leisurely lunch we will head back following the connector to the Old Dix Trail, descending over open ledges marked with small cairns. This trail directly faces the summit of Noonmark Mtn. The trail drops steeply into a small valley then crosses a small brook at 2.8 miles, connecting with the Old Dix Trail at 3.0 miles. Turning right, the trail crosses lcy Brook at 3.3 miles and merges with the Stimson trail to end at the golf course on Ausable Club Road slightly west of our starting point at 4.6 miles.

Access to Trailhead: A designated hikers parking lot is located on Ausable Club Road, at its southerly junction with Rte 73, south of St. Hubert. Coming from the north, turn left onto Ausable Club Road 5.9 miles north of the intersection of Rte 73 with Rte 9. Coming from the north on Rte 73, turn right on the second, more southerly Ausable Club Road, which is 2.7 miles (6 km) south of the painted Keene sign, 0.6 miles (1.4 km) south of St. Hubert and 0.4 miles (0.9 km) south of the northerly junction of Ausable Club Road with Rte 73.


The Jane Neale Fund
